### General Rules for Camp

- If your child fails to respect his or her counselor, director or staff member, he or she WILL be sent home.
- If your child brings items to camp that he or she should not have, they will be confiscated for the week. The camp director has the right to search any belongings brought to camp if he suspects contraband items.
- If your child's dress is inappropriate for our camp, he or she will be asked to change. No exposed midriffs, no tank-tops, no plunging necklines, no short-shorts, no inappropriate writing on clothing, etc.
- If your child is caught leaving his or her cabin after lights out without permission, he or she WILL be sent home. Under NO circumstances are boys and girls to be in each other's cabins.
- Participants are not permitted to operate machinery on campus; campers who drive will be asked to turn in keys. No one is allowed to leave campus without Director's permission.
- All incidents (such as accidents or unacceptable behavior) are to be reported to the Director as soon as possible.
- No physical contact allowed between boys and girls. No foul or suggestive language will be permitted. No inappropriate gestures. Failure to obey these rules will result in punishment or expulsion.

*In case of medical emergency, I understand every effort will be made to contact parents or guardians. In the event I cannot be reached, I hereby give permission to the physician selected by the event director to hospitalize and secure proper treatment and order injection or anesthesia or surgery for the participant named on this application. I also affirm that the medical information on this form is both complete and correct.*

## CAMP THREE FORKS TRAIL

**What to Bring:** Pencils/pen, notebook, Bible, sleeping bag, towels, ball glove, one-piece swimsuit, recreational clothing, light weight jacket, flashlight, rain poncho, extra pair of lace-up shoes (to wear on the river), insect repellent, eye glass safety strap for river trip.

**Please Remember:** This is the mountains so it will get cool as the sun goes down and gets colder before the sun comes up. Please bring some warm clothing. Also, the dew is heavy this time of the year, so plan on bringing an extra pair of tennis shoes and several extra pairs of socks.

**Arrival/Departure:** Arrival is 3:00pm on Saturday. Registration will not begin until 3:00pm. Departure will be at 10:00am on Friday.

## CAMP SUMMERS & MANGET

**What to Bring:** Pencils/pen, notebook, Bible, sleeping bag, towels, ball glove, one-piece swimsuit, recreational clothing, tennis shoes, flashlight, rain poncho, letter writing material.

**Arrival: 10:00am–11:00am** first day (**Monday**) of camp. Registration *will not* begin until 10:00am— young people cannot be left unattended until after they have been registered. Lunch will be served to the campers at 12:30.

**Departure: 10:00am** last day of camp. **NO LATER THAN 11:00am.**

**Handicap Dorm:** two rooms are available. You must make a reservation before camp for these accommodations.

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### ATTENTION: PARENTS, PASTORS, & YOUTH WORKERS

- Campers are expected to stay the entire camping period except for sickness or emergency.
- Please mark all luggage and clothing with camper's name.
- Campers are not permitted use of the phone.
- Parents are asked not to visit or call except in cases of emergency.
- Campers who drive must turn in their keys for the duration of the camp event.
- **Note:** It is our expressed desire that our camps glorify God in every way. Therefore, we request that all clothing be modest and everything brought to camp be appropriate for a God-honoring atmosphere. Shorts are to be modest in length; shirts should not reveal cleavage. ***Sleeveless shirts must have a 2 inch strap on the shoulder.*** Thank you for your cooperation.
- **Do Not Bring:** Food, short-shorts, tank tops, silly string, Tobacco products, alcoholic beverages, drugs, Vaseline, radios, CD or MP3 players, non-Christian reading materials, cell phones, and Sunday dress clothes.

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### CONDITIONS OF THE APPLICATION

1. Camp TFT Fee \$170. Camp Summers & Manget Fee \$150 (ages 6-12), \$160 (teens).
2. A \$25 deposit must accompany this application and returned by **June 1st**. Balance is payable in full on the first day of camp. Applications postmarked after June 1st will be accepted only as space is available.
3. **Free T-Shirt!** Applications with deposit postmarked before **May 1, 2012** will receive a free T-shirt. After this date, campers may purchase shirts for \$10.
4. Bring a first time camper and save \$20 off of the application fee. Both the old camper and new camper must preregister by **June 1st**.
5. Deposit will not be refunded or transferred to a sibling unless written notice of cancellation is post-marked before **June 1st**.
6. Camp fees are not refundable after the first day of camp.
7. Churches that are paying for campers must make PAYMENT no later than **BY THE END OF CAMP SEASON.**

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### DIRECTIONS TO THE CAMPS

#### CAMP THREE FORKS TRAIL

Lady Slipper Lane, Clayton, GA 30525

Three Forks Trail is located in the extreme North Eastern part of Georgia. It is approximately 7 miles south of Highlands, NC and 7 miles north of the SC/GA border line and very near the GA/NC border line off of Hwy 28. Coming from SC, take Hwy 28 North out of Walhalla, SC. When you cross the SC/GA border go 7 miles; then look for road to your left named Three Forks Trail Road (if you cross the GA/NC state line you have missed the road). After turning onto TFT road, look for a white iron gate and make a sharp right turn there.

#### CAMP SUMMERS AND MANGET

100 Camp Summers Lane, Cameron, SC 29030

From I-26 west and east take highway number 33 (exit 149) to Cameron. Just after entering the town limits, you will cross a railroad spur to a sawmill on your left after which take first paved road to the left, *Church Camp Road*. Camp Summers and Manget is 1.6 miles from highway 33 on the right. From Santee follow US 301 to US 176. Take US 176 to Cameron and in Cameron at the flashing light take a left onto Highway 33. Follow highway 22 to *Church Camp Road*. Make a right turn onto *Church Camp Road*. Camp Summers & Manget is 1.6 miles from highway 33 on the right.

From US 601 north take US 176 to Cameron, SC to flashing light. Make a right at the flashing light (highway 33) follow to *Church Camp Road*. Make a right turn onto *Church Camp Road*. Camp Summers & Manget is 1.6 miles from highway 33 on the right.

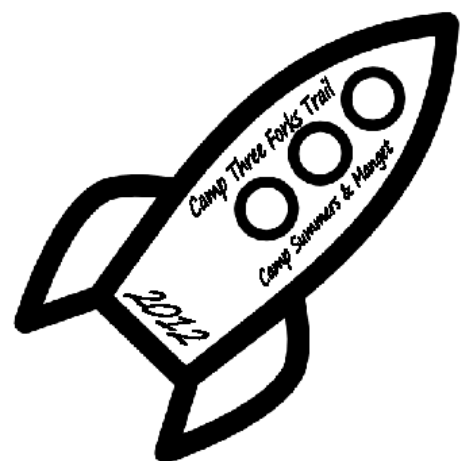
