

The History Of **Camp Three Forks Trail**

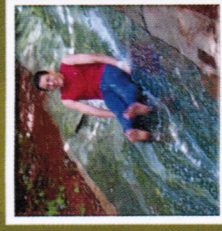
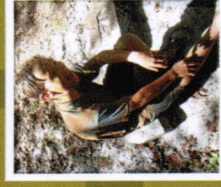

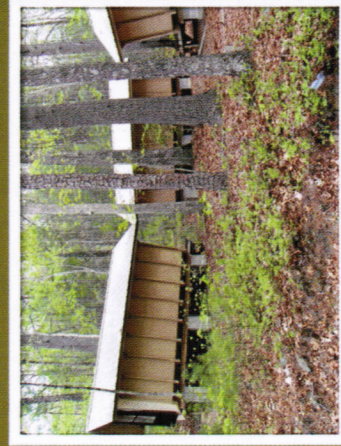

What Camp Three Forks Trail Has To Offer You

Camp Three Forks Trail is available for use throughout the year. With ten buildings and a total capacity of approximately 65, Camp TFT is perfect for organizations seeking a rustic, mountain facility to plan their retreats, family reunions or other activities. Camp TFT is away from the business of the world and offers an opportunity to enjoy God's beautiful creation in the mountains of northern Georgia.

The buildings include seven cabins as well as a duplex cabin, a bathhouse, a dining hall complex with kitchen, recreational fields, Faith Life Center, and endless hiking trails nearby.



Birdhouses

In total, there are seven cabins with the capacity of eight persons each. Cabins do not have heating or cooling units. However, the summer breeze at night keeps the cabins cool in the warmer months. There is also a duplex that sleeps approximately four people per side.

Dining Hall & Kitchen

The dining hall is equipped with a full kitchen with two refrigerator and freezer combos, an industrial size stove and oven, an ice machine, and a side by side commercial freezer. The dining hall has the available capacity of 100 people.

Bathhouse

The bathhouse contains women's and men's sides with three facilities, three showers, and two sinks each.

Faith Life Center

The Faith Life Center is a multi-purpose building which can be used for events, services, or activities. The building also contains bathrooms with showers, a refrigerator, washer, and dryer.

Recreation

Open fields provide plenty of area for recreation including softball, ultimate frisbee, or flag football. Numerous hiking trails also take you around the camp to enjoy the nature and God's creation.

Nearby Attractions

Along with the recreation activities at the camp, there are numerous nearby attractions. The tourist town of Highlands, NC is only 15 minutes from the camp facility and offers shopping, a community swimming pool, among other attractions. Numerous hiking trails, fishing locations, and waterfalls are within thirty minutes driving distance from the camp.
