CAMP SUMMERS & MANGET

What to Bring: Bible, twin bedding or sleeping bag, towels, one-piece swimsuit, recreational clothing, tennis shoes, flashlight, rain poncho/jacket, letter writing material.

Arrival: 10:00am—11:00am first day (**Monday**) of camp. Registration **will not** begin until 10:00am—young people cannot be left unattended until after they have been registered. Lunch will be served to the campers at 12:30.

Departure: 10:00am last day of camp. **NO LATER THAN 10:30am.**

Handicap Dorm: two rooms are available. You must make a reservation before camp for these accommodations.

CAMP THREE FORKS TRAIL

What to Bring: Bible, sleeping bag, towels, ball glove, one-piece swimsuit, recreational clothing, light weight jacket, flashlight, rain poncho, extra pair of lace-up shoes (to wear on the river), insect repellent, eye glass safety strap for river trip.

Please Remember: This is the mountains so it will get cool as the sun goes down and gets colder before the sun comes up. Please bring some warm clothing. Also, the dew is heavy this time of the year, so plan on bringing an extra pair of tennis shoes and several extra pairs of socks.

Arrival/Departure: Arrival is **3:00pm** on **Saturday**. Registration will not begin until 3:00pm. Departure will be at **10:00am** on **Friday**.

ATTENTION: PARENTS, PASTORS, & YOUTH WORKERS

- Campers are expected to stay the entire camping period except for sickness or emergency.
- Please mark all luggage and clothing with camper's name.
- Campers are not permitted use of the phone.
- Parents are asked not to visit or call except in cases of emergency.
- Campers who drive must turn in their keys for the duration of the camp event.
- **Note:** It is our expressed desire that our camps glorify God in every way. Therefore, we request that all clothing be modest and everything brought to camp be appropriate for a God-honoring atmosphere. Shorts are to be modest in length; shirts should not reveal cleavage. **Sleeveless shirts must have a 2 inch strap on the shoulder.** Thank you for your cooperation.
- **Do Not Bring:** FOOD (including energy drinks), short-shorts, tank tops, silly string, Tobacco products, alcohol, drugs, Vaseline, iPods/CD/MP3 players, cell phones, electronics (other than cameras), non-Christian reading materials, dress clothes.

CONDITIONS OF THE APPLICATION

1. Camp Summers & Manget Fee **\$165 (ages 6-12), \$175 (teens)**. Camp TFT Fee **\$185**.
2. A **\$25** deposit must accompany this application and returned by **June 1st**. Balance is payable in full on the first day of camp. Applications postmarked after June 1st will be accepted only as space is available and will be charged a \$25 late fee.
3. **Free T-Shirt!** Applications with deposit postmarked before **May 1** will receive a free T-shirt. After this date, campers may purchase shirts for **\$15** while supplies last.
4. If the application is filled out online, a bill will be sent to email given on application. Deposit and online application must be received by **May 1** to receive a free shirt.
5. First time campers save **\$20** off of the application fee. Camper must register by **June 1st** to receive the discount.
6. Deposit will not be refunded or transferred to a sibling unless written notice of cancellation is post-marked before **June 1st**.
7. Camp fees are not refundable after the first day of camp.
8. Churches that are paying for campers must make **PAYMENT** no later than **THE END OF CAMP SEASON**.

General Rules for Camp

- If your child fails to respect his or her counselor, director or staff member, he or she WILL be sent home.
- If your child brings items to camp that he or she should not have, they will be confiscated for the week. The camp director or an appointed camp worker has the right to search any belongings brought to camp if they suspect contraband items.
- If your child's dress is inappropriate for our camp, he or she will be asked to change. No exposed midriffs, no tank-tops, no plunging necklines, no short-shorts, no inappropriate writing on clothing, etc.
- If your child is caught leaving his or her cabin after lights out without permission, he or she WILL be sent home. Under NO circumstances are boys and girls to be in each other's cabins.
- Participants are not permitted to operate machinery on campus; campers who drive will be asked to turn in keys. No one is allowed to leave campus without Director's permission.
- All incidents (such as accidents or unacceptable behavior) are to be reported to the Director as soon as possible.
- No physical contact allowed between boys and girls. No foul or suggestive language will be permitted. No inappropriate gestures. Failure to obey these rules will result in punishment or expulsion.

In case of medical emergency, I understand every effort will be made to contact parents or guardians. In the event I cannot be reached, I hereby give permission to the physician selected by the event director to hospitalize and secure proper treatment and order injection or anesthesia or surgery for the participant named on this application. I also affirm that the medical information on this form is both complete and correct.

I authorize my child to be given the following over-the-counter medications as needed.
